2 **Rule.**

3 By consent, Rule is made returnable forthwith
and the matter is heard finally.

4 The Petitioner preferred an application for parole
on 18.12.2014. The said application and the appeal were
rejected hence, the Petitioner approached to this Court. By

order dated 20.4.2017, this Court granted parole to the Petitioner for a period of 30 days. Parole was granted to the Petitioner on the ground that hysterectomy operation has been advised. However, thereafter on 29.4.17, it was found that wife of the Petitioner had lumps in the breast. The case of the Petitioner is that his wife is required to undergo treatment for the same hence, extension of parole is sought.

5 Looking to the above facts, we are inclined to extend the period of parole for a further period of 30 days. It is made clear that under no circumstances any further extension of parole will be granted.

6 Rule is made absolute in the above terms.
