2. By this Application sent through jail, the Applicant seeks expeditious disposal of his case, being S. C. No.81 of 2015.

3. Mr. Parkar, Appointed as Amicus Curiae for the Applicant states that till date, charge has not been framed. He submits that the Applicant is in custody since 27.08.2014.
