1 The above Civil Application has been filed for condonation of delay of 133 days in filing the above Review Petition. The reasons for the delay are mentioned in paragraph 3 and 4 of the Civil Application. The sum and substance of the reasons is that the Applicant/Review Petitioner had applied under the Right to Information Act for getting the necessary information as regards the pension of the Respondent/husband. In the said process some time was lost resulting in the delay of 133 days in filing the above Review Petition.

2 The learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Respondent/husband Shri Ameya Deshpande opposes the above Civil Application, but ultimately leaves it to the Court.

3 Having regard to the reasons mentioned in the above Civil Application and considering the fact that the Applicant/Review Petitioner is prosecuting the proceedings in respect of her maintenance, a case for exercise of discretion in favour of the Applicant/Review Petitioner is made out. The above Civil Application is accordingly allowed and made absolute in terms of prayer clause (a). The above Civil Application is accordingly disposed of.
