1. The delay is of 436 days. It is explained in paragraphs 4, 5 and 6 of the Civil Application, in which the Applicant says that he had difficulty in raising the initial funds of Rs.25,000/- requiring for filing this Appeal. That in itself is sufficient cause.

2. The application is opposed but without an Affidavit in Reply. Time is sought to put in a reply. The request is declined. The delay in filing a reply is of six years, nearly six times longer than the delay sought to be condoned.

3. The delay is condoned.
4. The Civil Application is disposed of with no order as to costs.
