2. Mrs. Pai, learned APP on instructions makes a statement that FIR No. 3 of 2014 is already investigated by Kulgaon Police Station and charge-sheet has been filed in the concerned Court in the year 2014 itself. Statement is accepted.

3. In the light of above, we are not inclined to entertain this writ petition especially when the Petitioner has alternate remedy before the appropriate Court under the the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. In that view of the matter, writ petition is dismissed.
