1. The civil application was once dismissed and was restored by an order dated 18th September 2017. The applicants were required to take necessary steps and the order made it clear that in default the civil application would stand dismissed.
2. The civil application itself seeks that a delay of 1596 days be condoned. Without going into the merits of the matter, it is seen from the record that the civil application itself stands abated as

against respondents Nos. 1(a) and 1(b) vide the Registrar's order dated 10th October 2016, and dismissed as against respondent No. 1(c) by that same order. There is no application to set aside the order of abatement or dismissal.

3. The civil application cannot survive. It is dismissed. No costs.

4. In consequence, the civil revision application is also dismissed. No costs.
