The Civil Application is seeking condonation of delay of 159 days.

2 Over last several years, the matter is pending because the applicant/ appellant has failed to take steps to serve the respondent. Ultimately, on 2nd March, 2011 a notice issued to the sole respondent was returned with the bailiff's remark "**dead**".

3 From 2011 till date, no steps have been taken to bring on record the legal representatives of the deceased respondent. The

compensation amount involved in this appeal is Rs.34,250/-.

4 The appeal cannot proceed in such a fashion. The Civil Applications and consequently the First Appeal are, therefore, dismissed for non-prosecution.
