3 By this Petition under Article 227 of Constitution of India, the petitioner challenges the order dated 25.4.2017 passed by learned Sub-Divisional Officer in RTS Appeal No.35 of 2016 and order dated 29.6.2017 passed by learned Additional Collector in RTS Appeal No.60 of 2017.

4 The learned Counsel for the respondent
