No. 193 of 2014. The learned AGP submitted that the applicant is ready to deposit the entire amount of compensation alongwith interest accrued thereon.

In view of the above, the operation, implementation and execution of the impugned judgment and award is hereby stayed, subject to the applicant/State to deposit the entire amount of compensation alongwith interest accrued thereon on or before 23rd January, 2018 in the trial Court. If the amount is not deposited within the stipulated time, the stay granted by this Court will be vacated forthwith.
