2 By an order dated 2nd March, 2017, this Court had directed the respondent No. 1 to deposit an amount of Rs. 2,70,000/- in the trial Court within a period of two weeks from 2nd March, 2017 by way of

purging the contempt. The learned Counsel for the respondent has placed the receipt on record which shows that on 10/3/2017 pursuant to the order dated 2nd March, 2017 the respondent had deposited Rs. 2,70,000/- by way of cheque.
