1 In the case in question the charge sheet has been filed in 2006. The FIR has been registered on 21-2-2006. The Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the Petitioner sought to draw our attention to the material in the charge sheet in support of the case of the Petitioner that the complicity of the Petitioner is not seen. The FIR has been registered against the Petitioner and her husband Yasin Mohd for the offences punishable under Section 420 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code.
