1. None for the appellant. The appeal is yet to be registered since, the office objections have not been cleared.

2. The appeal is accompanied by an application for condonation of delay of 136 days. The delay is yet to be condoned, since, office objections are yet to be cleared.

3. The appeal itself, is against order dated 11 March 2011 by which the learned Trial Judge, has granted certain interim reliefs to operate during the pendency of the suit.

4. Since, the suit was of the year 2010, it is possible that the suit is already disposed of.

5. In any case, at this point of time, it will be futile to change this status-quo it prevails on account of the interim reliefs granted in the suit.
