1) In our view the selection process is over and the

e) Be pleased to direct the respondent No.1 to consider the complaint dated 23rd April 2015 and 25th July, 2016 filed by the petitioner.

f) Ad interim relief in terms of prayer clause (c) and (d) above be granted.

2) In our view, the petition has become infructuous. The petitioner is at liberty to challenge the order of rejection by filing a fresh petition. All contentions of the petitioner are kept open if he files a fresh petition.
