The Petitioner herein has challenged the order of issuance of process dated 6th June, 2017 passed by the learned Metropolitan Magistrate, 18th Court, Girgaon, Mumbai. Considering that there is efficacious alternative remedy available to the Petitioner, Mr. Niranjana Mundargi, the learned counsel for the Petitioner, under instructions, seeks leave to withdraw the Petition with liberty to file revision application before the Sessions Court alongwith application for condonation of delay, if necessary. Leave with liberty as prayed for is granted.

Petitioner is unwell and is unable to appear before the lower court. He has submitted that the warrant has already been issued against the Petitioner.
