1. There is no case made out to interfere with the time schedule fixed by the learned trial Judge for disposal of the suits within a period of one month. There is no reason to proceed on the basis that such a direction will result in breach of natural justice. In a case, where circumstance exists for some accommodation or adjustment, there is no doubt that learned trial Judge will exercise his discretion in a judicious manner. However, there is no case made out to interfere with the directions, fixing the time schedule. Learned

counsel Mr. Joshi submits that Petitioner (original Defendant) will proceed in the suit on the next date i.e. 18th September, 2017. Writ petition is therefore disposed of.
