1. On 06/06/2017, this Court passed the following order :-

“On 27th February, 2017, this Court passed the following order :-

“Perused the order dated 25th January, 2017. Time was granted to the petitioners to take appropriate steps in the light of the said order as the petitioners are not entitled to appear in person. Both the petitioners are not present. Place the petition on 27th March, 2017 under the caption of “Dismissal”. Registry to forward a copy of this order to the petitioners at the addresses of the petitioners mentioned in the cause title.”
