1. Petitioner has challenged the order dated 31.12.2013 passed by the Additional Commissioner, Pune Division, Pune in RTS/Revision/492/2011. The petitioner is having substantive alternate remedy at his command by way of further revision before the State of Maharashtra as held by Apex Court in the case of Gurudassing Nawoosingh Panjwani vs. State of Maharashtra and ors. reported in (2016) 2 SCC 213.
