1. Mr. Patil, the learned Counsel for the Petitioner at the outset makes a statement that he is restricting this writ petition to the relief claimed in prayer clause (a). By the said prayer clause, the Petitioner is seeking direction to the Respondents to decide his application expeditiously. The prayer, in our view, is innocuous.
