Mr. Purwant, learned counsel for the applicants, seeks leave to withdraw the application with liberty to file a discharge application in the Trial Court, in the event, charge-sheet is filed in the subject crime against the applicant for the offence punishable under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.
