1 The applicant, who is accused in Crime No.II-19 of
2017 for offences punishable under Sections 3 and 7 of the

ORDER

- i) The application is allowed.

- iii) In addition to the conditions imposed by the order dated 19th September 2017, the applicant / accused to attend the concerned Police Station, as and when required by the Investigating Officer, by a written notice.
- iv) The applicant / accused shall not directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case, so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to the Police Officer.
- v) The applicant / accused shall not leave India without the prior permission of the Court.
