1. The Petitioner is present with her counsel. The learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that the Petitioner may be permitted to withdraw these petitions with liberty to the Petitioner to submit a representation in regard to her retiral benefits before

2. The prayer has not been opposed by the learned counsel appearing for the Respondent.

On receipt of the same the competent authority of the Respondent shall examine the same and shall take appropriate decision on it in accordance with law. In case any amount is found to be due and payable the same is disbursed to her within three months from the date of receipt of the representation.
