

In view thereof, the Petitioner-father is constrained to approach this Court.

3] It is submitted by learned counsel for the Petitioner that the Petitioner is the father and also a qualified medical expert in the field. He is coming to India from U.K. today night only to meet his child and he will be in India till 27/10/2017. During this period, he wants to have the interim custody of the child not only for meeting him but also for the medical purpose.

4] In view thereof, there should not be any reason for the Respondent, who is a grandmother of child to resist the application. The father is having every right to meet his child and to have access and his interim custody in Diwali Vacation.

5] Hence, the Writ Petition is allowed. The Petitioner-father is given interim custody of the child-Darsh from 16/10/2017 at 10.00 am till 26/10/2017 at 6.00 pm.

6] Learned counsel for the Respondent submits that the Petitioner may pick up the child from the house of Respondent on 16/10/2016 at 10.00 am and will return the child to the Respondent on 26/10/2017 at 6.00 pm at her residence. Ordered accordingly.

7] The Writ Petition is disposed of in above terms.
