1 Heard the learned AGP for the Applicant.

2 The applicant had preferred Writ Petition Stamp No. 13126 of 2016. On 9.12.2016 as per order of Registrar Judicial-I the applicant was granted four weeks' time to remove office objections, failing which, registration of Writ Petition (Stamp)

No. 13126 of 2016 shall stand dismissed. The office note dated 7.10.2017 shows that "as per above Registrar (Judicial-I) order, the advocate for the petitioner has not removed the office objections, within stipulated time, hence, the order dated 9.12.2016 stands and Writ Petition (Stamp) No. 13126 of 2016 shall stand dismissed for non-prosecution". Thus, the writ petition was dismissed for non-prosecution. The applicant is now seeking restoration of the said Writ Petition.
