1. Ms. Mehandale, the learned advocate for the petitioner states that the petitioner has today received the last

Demand Draft in the sum of Rs.25,000/-. With that nothing remains in the petitions for consideration of the Court. The writ petitions are accordingly disposed off.

2. Ms. Mehandale further points out that respondent no.2 is yet to pay the costs awarded by the trial Court Rs.1,200/- to the petitioner. The opportunity given to respondent no.1 to examine himself and a witness before the trial Court will be subject to payment of costs of Rs.1,200/-.
