1. Petition is filed for following reliefs :

“a. that this Hon'ble Court be pleased to issue appropriate writ order and direction directing the Respondents to forthwith take cognizance in respect of the complaints made by the Petitioner against the named persons and take appropriate legal action in accordance with law including the action of initiating Chapter and Externment proceedings as permissible under the provisions of law.

b. that this Hon'ble Court be pleased to issue appropriate writ, order and direction directing the Respondents to forthwith restore the law and order situation and remove the terror of the persons named in the complaint to the public at large residing in the said vicinity by taking appropriate legal steps in accordance with law.”
