

2 Undoubtedly, the Petitioner is receiving grant-in-aid from the State Government. It is for the State Government to decide that the teachers who are declared surplus in other schools would be first absorbed in the schools which are receiving grant-in-aid. Such a policy cannot be said to be unreasonable. This policy has been formulated with an intention of not putting undue burden on the public exchequer.

3 We find no merit in this Writ Petition and the same is dismissed with no order as to costs.
