2. The Civil Application seeks an extension of time by eight week to make the deposit ordered by MS Sonak J on 12th October 2017 order. That was an order by consent and in that order Applicant/Petitioner agreed to make a deposit at the rate of Rs. 2 lakhs per month within eight weeks.
