1 The prayers in the civil application seek a review of the order dated 26 March 2012 passed by this court, whereby the petition came to be allowed. Perusal of the letter submitted by the advocate for the original petitioner addressed to the Registrar A.S., indicates that in pursuance of the orders passed by this court, a decree was lawfully executed and possession was taken on 5 December 2012 by the original

petitioner, Smt. Sulbha Kashinath Sawant. Thereafter, Smt. Sulbha Kashinath Sawant surrendered the possession of the suit premises to respondent no.2. On 26 January 2016, Smt. Sulbha Kashinath Sawant has expired.
