1. The Leave Petition was allowed on 2nd March 2017.

2. Mr. Manish Hiranand Lund, Proprietor of the Defendant, who is personally present in Court, submits to a decree in terms of prayer clauses (a), (b) and (d) of the Suit. Mr. Kane, therefore, does not press the prayer for damages.

3. The Suit is decreed in these terms with no order as to costs. Drawn up decree is dispensed with. Refund of Court Fees, if any, in accordance with the Rules.

4. The Court Receiver had sealed certain goods. These are to be destroyed after removing the goods from the impugned packaging by the Defendants at their cost within a period of 12 weeks. 5. The Court Receiver stands discharged without passing accounts but on payment of his costs, charges and expenses within four weeks from today by the Plaintiffs.
