1 Ms.Pawar appearing for petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the petition. Mr.Nagar appearing for respondent no.1 states that the director of respondent no.1 has complied with the directions given in the order dated 17.2.2017. Ms.Pawar for petitioner does not dispute the statement.

Petition accordingly, dismissed as withdrawn.

2 The Court Receiver stands discharged without passing of account. The undertaking of the counsel for petitioner that if there
