1. Heard the learned counsel for the applicant.
2. Advocate for the applicant submits that notice is duly served on opponent no.1. He submits that affidavit of service is already filed in the Registry. He further makes a statement that he received instruction from his client not to proceed against opponent no.2. To that effect, he has given in writing. Same is taken on record and marked 'X' for identification. Same is accepted.
