1 Commercial Appeal (L.) No.41 of 2017 was heard on merits. On 19.07.2017, at the request of the parties, the Appeal was adjourned for today, as some workable proposals before commencement of the arbitration were to be discussed and settled in between the parties.

2 Without prejudice to the rights and contentions of both the parties i.e. the Appellant and the contesting Respondents have submitted consent minutes of order today before us in Notice of Motion (L) No. 27 of 2017.
