If such an appeal is filed within two weeks, the same may be considered on merits and in accordance with the law.

If an application for stay is filed, the same shall be decided, after hearing the parties expeditiously, within two weeks thereafter,

So far as prayer clause (b) is concerned, the petitioners have a remedy of approaching the other appropriate forum.

Reserving the said right, the writ petition is disposed of.
