1. Pursuant to the order dated 7th June, 2016, the petitioner has already filed affidavit of service. The proclamation was issued by the office. No objection has been raised pursuant to the said proclamation.

2. By this petition filed under section 2 of the Bombay Regulation Act VIII of 1827, the petitioner seeks issuance of legal heirship certificate in respect of Mr.Anand Paramjit Singh, who died on 31st October, 2013. A copy of the death certificate is annexed.
