1 The plaintiff and the defendants have entered into consent terms dated 1st April, 2017. The consent terms signed by the authorised signatory of the plaintiff – Mr. Audip Ghosh, partner of defendant no.1 – Mr. Neeraj Mahendra Shah, defendant no.2 and their respective advocates is taken on record and marked 'X' for identification.

2 Mr. Neeraj Mahendra Shah, who has signed for defendant no.1 as partner states that defendant no.2 – Mr. Sanyal Desai is also a partner of defendant no.1 and both Mr. Shah and counsel for plaintiff identify the signature of defendant no.2 and make a solemn statement that it has been signed by defendant no.2.
