3 Upon the Defendant making the payment as set out herein without committing any default, the decree to be marked as **“fully satisfied”**.

4 In case the Defendant commits any default in making payment of any installment or any part thereof, the Plaintiff

shall be entitled to execute the decree for the full amount as prayed for in the plaint after giving credit of any payments already made by the Defendant.

5 The decree is passed against the Defendant in terms of this consent order and the suit is disposed of in terms thereof. The Plaintiff shall be entitled to refund of court fees, if any, as per rules. There shall be no order as to costs. In view of disposal of the suit, nothing survives in the Summons for Judgment and the same is disposed of accordingly.
