2. Parties through their counsel.
3. After arguing at length on the basis of broad consensus arrived between the parties during the course of hearing, we dispose of this Petition by directing the Apex Grievance Redressal Committee to consider and decide the Petitioners' application for the interim relief filed in Appeal No. 01 of 2017 as expeditiously as possible but not later than 30th November, 2017.

6. Needless to say that the aforesaid statement will not come in the way of the Respondent No. 4 while arguing the matter before the Committee.
