1. This Chamber Summons is for amendment to bring subsequent events on record including *inter alia* in relation to registered Deed of Conveyance dated 2nd June 2011. The Chamber Summons is served on all but Defendants Nos. 15 and 16, who are said to untraceable despite the fact that their Advocate entered appearance and they filed a Written Statement.
