1. By consent, the Leave Petition is made absolute.

2. Mr Rizwan Raza H Rizvi, Proprietor of the Defendant is personally present in Court. He submits to a decree in terms of prayer clauses (a), (b) and (d) of the Suit. Mr Kane does not, therefore, press his prayer for damages.
