This application is moved by the Divisional Joint Registrar, Co-operative Societies praying that the effect, operation and implementation of the judgment passed by this Court in Writ Petition No.6220/2016 on 07-03-2017 be kept in abeyance for eight weeks to enable the respondent Nos.1 and 2 to take appropriate steps in the matter. Though it is submitted that the Authorized Officer (Administrator) is a Government Officer and no prejudice would be caused to the members of the executive committee of the co-operative society if the effect, operation and implementation of the judgment is kept in abeyance, it is not understood what prejudice is caused to the Divisional Joint Registrar, Co-operative Societies who in this matter exercises the quasi-judicial powers. The respondent No.2 has not been able to make out any case for grant of the prayer made in this civil

application.

The civil application is dismissed. No costs.
