- [2] Whether the appellate Court was justified in disturbing the finding of fact recorded by the trial Court that when Notification under Section 9 of the said Act dated 17th February, 1990 was issued, the land Survey No. 626 was one piece land and hence the plaintiffs were not entitled to claim separate benefits under the policy of the Western Coalfields Ltd.?
