Applicant No. 1 – wife, applicant No. 2 – husband and applicant No. 3 – mother of applicant No. 2 are before this Court in joint application, pointing out that matrimonial dispute between the parties is amicably settled and hence FIR registered at the instance of applicant No. 1 vide FIR No. 19 of 2015 under Sections 498A and 34 of IPC, should be set aside.
