The applicant, apprehending arrest in crime registered against him for the offence punishable under Section 420 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, has sought pre-arrest bail.

Shri S.P. Deshpande, learned Additional Public Prosecutor has pointed out from paragraph 3 of the order passed by the Sessions Court that other complaints of similar nature are registered against the applicant and co-accused Akshay. The applicant has not made any statement in the application about his criminal antecedents.

For want of necessary details, the application is **dismissed** with liberty to the applicant to file fresh application giving all the details, if so advised.
