The petitioner/ employer has challenged the interim order granted by the Industrial Court in favour of the employee staying the effect and operation of the transfer order dated 23rd May, 2016. The impugned order is passed on 20th June, 2016. In my view, it would not be appropriate to interfere with the interim order specially when it is operating for about 8 months.

The petition is **dismissed**. No costs.

At this stage, the learned advocate for the petitioner/ employer makes a grievance that because of the impugned order the employer will not be able to consider the case of the petitioner for transfer in April-May, 2017. The petitioner – employer is at liberty to file appropriate application before the Industrial Court pointing out its difficulty / grievance in the matter. If such application is filed, the Industrial Court shall decide the application according to law.
