This is an application for condonation of delay of 1485 days in filing the first appeal. The reasons for delay are stated in paragraphs 3 and 4 of the application. The application is opposed by learned counsel for the respondents.

Considering reasons mentioned in the application as sufficient cause is made out and in view of law laid down in case of Imrat Lal, the delay stands condoned subject to condition of claimant not being entitled for interest on the amount of compensation if enhanced for the period from 05/04/2012 till 23/06/2017.

Civil application is allowed and disposed of.
