By this application it is prayed that the second appeal be disposed of in view of the fact that the parties have arrived at a compromise amongst themselves.

The appellants are the original defendants in a suit for partition filed by respondent No.1. In the application it is stated that the respective parties have relinquished their shares in favour of the other parties and on that basis necessary documents have been executed. It is further stated that the parties have been put in possession of their respective shares. The application is signed by all the parties.
