The prayer made on behalf of the respondent/
employee for permission to withdraw the amount deposited
by the petitioner cannot be granted as after hearing the
parties this Court directed that the amount be kept in fixed
deposit in the nationalized bank.

respondent/ employee for grant of early hearing is not
