2] The applicant is apprehending his arrested in
connection with Crime No.255/2017, registered with
P.S.Chandur Railway,District-Amravati, for the offence
punishable under Sections 419,420,468,471 and 379
r/w Section 34 of the Indian penal Code.

owner of Tamba Ghat-2.
