By this application it is prayed that the delay in filing cross-objection be condoned. The reasons for delay are stated in paragraphs 2,3 and 4 of the application.

The application is opposed by learned counsel for original appellant-VIDC by stating that the reasons as assigned are not sufficient. Considering reasons mentioned in the application, the delay in filing cross-objection is condoned subject to the claimants/cross-objectors not being entitled for interest on the amount of compensation if enhanced for the period from 12/04/2013 till date. Delay in filing cross-objection is condoned in aforesaid terms.
