Before notices of petition could be issued, the petition is dismissed as registration of petition is refused by the learned Registrar (J.) for non-removal of the office objections. As the petition came to be dismissed before notices of writ petition could be issued to the respondents, without issuing notices to the respondents and accepting the explanation given in the application, delay of 42 days in filing the miscellaneous civil application is condoned. The civil application is **allowed**. No costs.

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For the same reasons recorded above, the

order of learned Registrar (J.) refusing registration is set aside and writ petition is restored. Miscellaneous civil application is allowed accordingly. No costs.
